Most Reverend Victor Tamayo Monsignor Tamayo served as Vicar Cooperative of Metropolitan Cathedral, parish priest of 6 parishes. Chaplain at the Naval School of Non-Commissioned Officers ARC Barranquilla, Treasurer and Vicar of Administration of the Regional Seminar and General Vicar of the Archdiocese. By mandate by the Holy Father John Paul II, he was elected Bishop of Vocariana and Auxiliary of the Archdiocese of Barranquilla, and ordained a Bishop in 2004. We recognize his tireless work in the construction of housing for priests, and in the social transformation of the most disadvantaged, first as a priest and now as a Bishop. His mission includes the campaign of Catedratón, which helps support evangelization.

Monsignor John Brady The Spiritual Director of CWIA, Monsignor Brady founded Ministr-O-Media to record and publish major retreats and conferences given by Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen, and distributed over a million tapes worldwide. He helped compile/edit "Through the Year" with Fulton Sheen. An Eagle Scout, he published "Higher Than Eagles", an interfaith book of meditations on Scout Law, used by 7,000 Scouts and Leaders. The Washington Archdiocesan Scout chaplain for Boy Scouting, Girl Scouting, and Camp Fire, he is recognized at a national level for outstanding service to Catholic Scouting, and currently serves as acting Scouting chaplain for Catholic dioceses in Maryland, Virginia, West Virginia, Delaware, and Washington, D.C.

Fr. Zygmunt Kurawinski Born in Warsaw, Poland, his vocation was gradually discovered in the Neocatechumenal Way (the Catholic Initiation for Adults). After a discernment process he felt called to be a missionary priest and after high school studied at the Redemptoris Mater Archdiocesan Missionary Seminary in Newark, NJ. He completed a 2 year missionary experience in Estonia and throughout the US (a part of the seminary formation process), he was transferred to Washington DC, where he received his priestly ordination in 2003. Father served as a parochial vicar at Holy Redeemer - Kensington, Chaplain at American University, and as Cardinal McCarrick's secretary. He was later assigned as parochial vicar at Immaculate Heart of Mary, Lexington Park. In 2010-2011, he did missionary work in Alaska. Currently, Father Zygmunt serves as a parochial vicar at St. Peter's Church in Waldorf, Maryland.

Deacon Darrell Wentworth Deacon Darrell was ordained a permanent Deacon in 2003 in the diocese of Richmond, Virginia after graduating from St. Meinrad Seminary. He has served the Church in many capacities involving one-on-one and program evangelization as well as ecumenical relations with Christians of other traditions. He is the Spiritual Director and Moderator of New Creation Community, a Private Association of the Christian Faithful of Pontifical Right, the Liaison for the Bishop of Richmond to Christians of Pentecostal and Charismatic Traditions, and the Bishop's Liaison for Charismatic Renewal in the Diocese of Richmond. Together with two Pentecostal ministers he built a medical clinic out of a 40 foot long international shipping container.

John C. Haughey, S.J John, a former professor of religious ethics at Loyola University Chicago, taught theology at Georgetown University and Fordham University, and had chairs at Seton Hall University, John Carroll University, and Marquette University. Appointed by the Vatican's Council on Christian Unity, he served as a member of its international dialogues with Pentecostalism and World Evangelical Alliance. He was Associate and Corresponding Editor for America magazine. A founding member of the Woodstock Theological Center, is Senior Fellow. Fr. Haughey coordinates Woodstock's Catholic Higher Education project and has been honored for outstanding contributions to Catholic higher education. He has authored several books.

Evangelist Stella Davis Founder and President of Christian Women In Action, Stella is being used by God in her international teaching and healing ministry. A busy wife, mother, grandmother, and a homemaker, Stella is a student at Notre Dame Graduate School and the author of "Giving God The Praise," and "Spiritual Warfare for Catholics." She was commissioned by Father Professor Michael Scanlan, T.O.R., in 1980 at the University of Steubenville, Bible Institute as an evangelist, preaching and teaching from the Word of God. A member of the IAD Healing Ministries, she's been featured on Christian TV and radio. Thousands have come to the Lord through her ministry. She gives all glory to God who called and equipped her into this ministry. Stella is also an extraordinary minister of the Eucharist.

Salvatore Ciresi Professor Ciresi is the founder and director of the St. Jerome Biblical Guild, and publishes *Veritas Scripturae: The Bulletin of the St. Jerome Biblical Guild*. Sal served two tours in the U.S. Marine Corps, and is now employed in the aviation sector. He earned his M.A. in Theological Studies from Christendom College's Graduate School, where he serves as an adjunct professor. Past host of "Catholic radio show "Cross Talk", he contributes to several Catholic publications.
