Most Reverend Victor Tamayo We welcome Bishop Tamayo from Barranquilla, Columbia as he joins us in praise, worship and fellowship. Bishop Tamayo will share his personal experience with the people of Barranquilla and the challenges faced in starting a new parish where there is such great need. Hear how the Holy Spirit has been working to bring us all together to help the poorest of the poor!

Monsignor John Brady A priest for 52 years, and the Spiritual Director of CWIA, Monsignor John Brady founded Ministr-O-Media to record and publish major retreats and conferences given by Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen from 1974, and distributed over one million cassette tapes throughout the world. He helped compile/edit "Through the Year" with Fulton Sheen. Monsignor Brady, an Eagle Scout, published "Higher Than Eagles", an interfaith book of meditations on Scout Law, used by 7,000 Scouts and Leaders.

Donna Camille Jones is the wife of Deacon Alex C. Jones, the mother of three grown sons, and grandmother to ten grandchildren. Born in Chicago, Illinois and raised in Gary Indiana, Donna moved to Detroit in 1966 as the wife of Alex Jones. She was an integral part of her husband's pastoral ministry as he pastored two Detroit area churches and worked closely with the women in holding workshops, counseling sessions, prayer breakfasts, field trips, retreats, etc. Since their entrance into the Roman Catholic Church in 2000, God has blessed them and made them a blessing to His people throughout the world. Their mission is to love and serve all people of good will, especially those who know and love our Lord Jesus Christ.

Tim Staples Raised a Southern Baptist, he fell away from the faith, but came back to faith in Christ during his late teen years through the witness of Christian televangelists. Tim joined the Marine Corps and became involved in ministry. During his final year, Tim was challenged to study Catholicism from Catholic and historical sources. That encounter sparked a two-year search for the truth. He was determined to prove Catholicism wrong; he ended up studying his way to the last place he thought he end up: the Catholic Church! He converted to Catholicism in 1988 and spent six years in formation for the priesthood. Tim left the seminary in 1994 and has been working in Catholic apologetics and evangelization ever since.
